RURAL HOUSING

Financed 30.24 lakh units under Golden Jubilee Rural Housing Finance Scheme (GJRHFS) and Rural Housing Fund (RHF). GJRHFS and RHF financed 28.59 lakh units in 1997-2010 and 1.65 lakh units in 2008-2010, respectively. NHB also refines primary lending institutions under these schemes.



LOW – INCOME HOUSING

Till end of the June 2010, the Bank has sanctioned 426 projects having project cost of ₹5667.75 crore and loan component of ₹ 4449.56 crore to provide low income housing for the poor and has financed various agencies including Public Housing Agencies, MFI/NGOs, Public Private Partnership projects. By providing long term financial support, technical assistance and training, the Bank has engaged many MFIs/NGOs in housing finance. For this, the Bank has sanctioned ₹ 83.92 crore to 23 Microfinance Institutions in 9 states covering 16,207 housing units (urban and rural). NHB has launched its water and sanitation programme with the main objective to advance the total sanitation campaign of the Government of India. ₹ 1 crore has been lent by NHB for construction of around 1056 toilets.

NHB RESIDEX

NHB RESIDEX is the country's first residential property price index to capture the price movements in residential properties in a comprehensive manner. It is based on actual transaction prices to reflect the market trends. NHB RESIDEX has been extended from 5 cities to 15 cities and its coverage now includes Ahmedabad, Faridabad, Chennai, Kochi, Hyderabad, Jaipur, Patna, Lucknow, Pune and Surat. NHB RESIDEX is now being updated on a quarterly basis with 2007 as the base year.

It's an effort to bring together individuals and institutions in housing and housing finance for promoting research, exchange of knowledge and communication and to create a repository of information.



NEW BUSINESS INITIATIVES

- Women Housing – A Breakthrough**
 Under Rural Housing Fund 87,578 rural women were provided housing finance.
- Public Private Partnership – Welcoming Changes**
 NHB has financed a Mass Housing Project of the Government of West Bengal for EWS/LIG segments through Public Private Partnership to provide low income housing for the poor.
- Towards A Better Tomorrow - Energy Efficient Housing**
 NHB is promoting and financing Energy Efficient New Residential Housing and related Infrastructure through financial intermediaries, with credit support from KfW, Germany.
- NHB - A Nodal Agency**
 NHB is acting as the Nodal Agency for Government of India's Interest Subsidy Scheme for Housing the Urban Poor and 1% Interest Subvention Scheme for housing loans up to ₹10 lakh (for Housing Finance Companies).
