1822(2008) on Taliban /AL-Qaida Organization**



Before opening any new account, it should be ensured that the name/s of the proposed customer does not appear in the list; further HFCs should scan all existing accounts to ensure that no account is held by or linked to any of the entities or individuals included in the list.

The Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1267 (1999) concerning Al-Qaida and the Taliban and Associated Individuals and Entities presents his compliments to the Permanent Representatives and Observers to the United Nations and wishes to convey the following:

On **20 April 2011**, the Committee approved the **amendments** specified with strikethrough and underline in the three entries below to its Consolidated List of individuals and entities subject to the assets freeze, travel ban and arms embargo set out in paragraph 1 of Security Council resolution 1904 (2009) adopted under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations.

The Committee's List is updated regularly on the basis of relevant information provided by Member States and international and regional organizations. This is the sixth update of the List in 2011.

1. The first part of the report is devoted to a description of the experimental apparatus and the method of measurement.

The apparatus consists of a cylindrical vessel of diameter  $d$  and height  $h$ , filled with a liquid of density  $\rho$ . The vessel is placed on a platform scale. The liquid is heated from below by a coil of resistance wire. The temperature of the liquid is measured by a thermocouple.

The scale is connected to a galvanometer which is calibrated in grams. The deflection of the galvanometer is measured as a function of the time  $t$  after the liquid is heated. The deflection is found to increase with time and to approach a constant value.

The constant value of the deflection is found to be independent of the diameter  $d$  and the height  $h$  of the vessel. It is also independent of the density  $\rho$  of the liquid. The constant value is found to be proportional to the square of the time  $t$ .

The results of the experiment are shown in the following table. The deflection  $D$  is measured in grams, and the time  $t$  is measured in seconds.
