

Examination Notice: Recruitment of Officers in JMGS-I (ASSISTANT MANAGER)

Reference is invited to the Advertisement No. – NHB/HR & Admin./Recruitment/2022-23/01 dated 30.10.2022 published on the NHB website and in the Employment News/Rozgar Samachar dated 29.10.2022 on the Recruitment of Officers in JMGS-I (ASSISTANT MANAGER).

In this regard, it is notified for the information of all candidates applied for the Post Assistant Managers (Scale-I) that the Bank is conducting online written examination for the said Post on **24.12.2022 (Saturday)** across various centres in the country. Candidates registered for the examination can download their respective e-Call Letters from the website of NHB ([http: www.nhb.org.in](http://www.nhb.org.in)) from 12.12.2022 onwards. Candidates are advised to download e-Call Letters well in advance to avoid last minute rush. No paper-based Call Letter will be issued for this examination.

Candidates must produce their e-Call Letter with recent photograph affixed thereon and a valid photo identity proof in ORIGINAL as well as photocopy of the ID proof at the allotted venue for appearing in the examination. Candidates are advised to read all the instructions mentioned on their e-Call Letter and observe the same. Besides e-Call Letter & ID proof related documents, following items are permitted to carry into the examination venue -

- a. **Mask (WEARING A MASK is MANDATORY)**
- b. **Gloves**
- c. **Personal transparent water bottle (Candidate should bring his / her own water bottle)**
- d. **Personal hand sanitizer (50 ml)**
- e. **A simple pen**
- f. **In case of Scribe Candidates - Scribe form duly filled and signed with Photograph affixed.**

Candidates must follow the COVID-19 norms of social distancing as well as personal hygiene inside the examination hall and in the premises of the Venue.

A Candidate must have the Aarogya Setu App installed on his/her mobile phone indicating the Candidate's COVID-19 risk factor. A candidate will have to show his/her COVID-19 risk status to the Security Guard at the entrance of the exam venue. In case a candidate does not have a smart phone, he/she will have to bring in a signed declaration to this effect (self-declaration format is provided along with the e-Call Letter) and show the same to the Security Guard at the entrance of the exam venue. After showing the risk status at the entrance, candidates will be required to switch off their mobile phones and deposit the same at the designated location, to be collected while exiting. Temperature of candidates (and Scribe, if applicable) will be checked at the entrance of the exam venue through thermo guns.

Candidates are advised not to bring any valuables/costly items and bags to the examination hall, as safe keeping of the same cannot be assured.

Candidates must report at the examination venue 15 minutes before the time mentioned on the e-Call Letter. Candidates reporting late will not be allowed to appear in the online examination. Further, the candidates will not be allowed to leave the examination venue without prior permission of the test administrator.

Candidates may please note that any request for change of date/session/venue of the examination will not be entertained.
