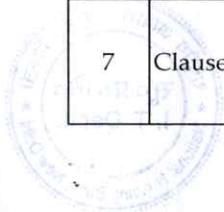

Instead of mandating three POs with more than 300 users each, we suggest accepting any one of the following combinations as valid: 1 PO with more than 1000 users 2 POs with more than 750 users each 3 POs with more than 300 users each (as currently specified) Justification: The proposed amendment would enable broader participation from capable bidders who have executed large-scale MDM projects under fewer contracts. This would encourage fair and healthy competition, attracting both technically strong (T1) and cost-effective (L1) bidders. Ultimately, it will benefit your organization by ensuring wider participation and the best value in this prestigious project.
